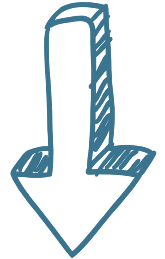

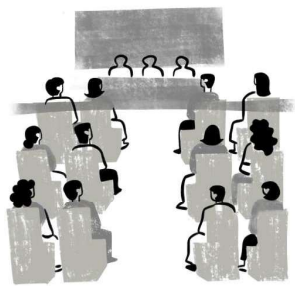

## Lifeguard Preparation Workshop

Are you interested in becoming a lifeguard but unsure whether you have the swimming ability to qualify? The city of Patterson will host two Lifeguard Preparation workshop days for those interested in working as a Lifeguard for the City of Patterson in the 2026 season. The workshop will feature three water stations designed to cover the three prerequisites for becoming a Lifeguard. Upon successful completion, participants will be placed in one of our two Lifeguard Certification Classes with Title 22, free of charge. During the workshop, participants can apply for the city's Lifeguard position. The pre-test will not be required upon passing the workshop since the prerequisites will be covered during the sessions. However, completing the workshop does not guarantee employment as a Lifeguard for the City of Patterson. Applicants will still need to pass other hiring steps, such as interviews, background checks, and a drug test, and hiring will depend on operational needs. Registration is required for these events.

## Lifeguard Certification Classes W/ Title 22

The City of Patterson proudly offers American Red Cross Lifeguarding courses to help individuals gain the knowledge and skills necessary to become certified Lifeguards. This course also teaches participants Title 22 (First Aid for Public Safety Personnel), providing them with additional skill practice and higher-level medical training and knowledge than the introductory lifeguard class. Participants must complete all skills and attend all sessions to become certified. Upon successful completion, participants will be certified by the American Red Cross in Lifeguarding, CPR/AED, First Aid, and Title 22 for a period of 2 years. **Participants must complete the pre-test or hiring workshop to participate in the Lifeguard class. The pre-test will be held 1 hour before the first day of class.**

- 150-yard swim using front crawl or breaststroke, followed by 2 minutes of treading water using only legs and an additional 50-yard swim.
- A timed pre-test that consists of a 20-yard swim to retrieve a 10 lb. brick from at least a 7-foot depth of water

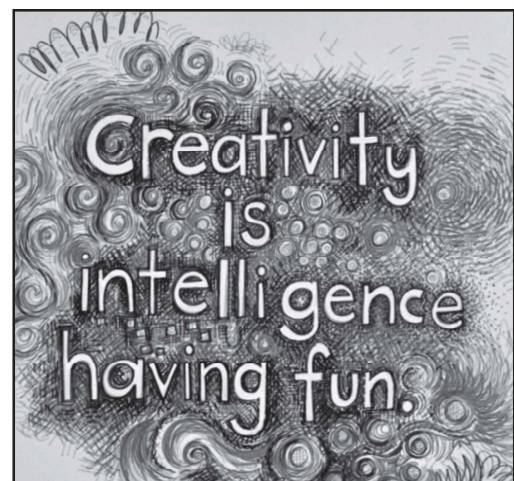

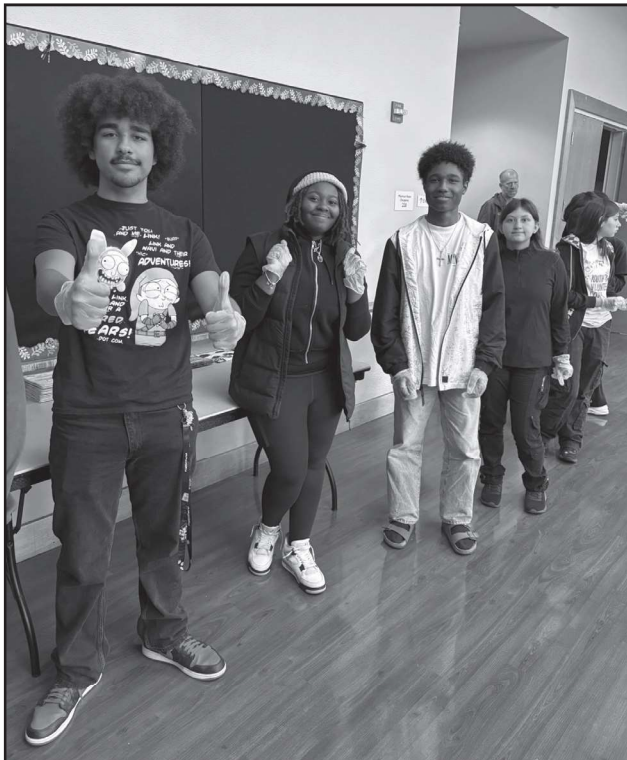
## Youth Volunteer Corps

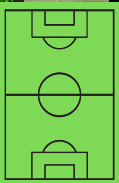
