EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS

<u>ZONE</u>	<u>EXPLANATION</u>
Zone A	No base flood elevations determined.
Zone AE	Base flood elevations determined.
Zone AH	Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually area of ponding); base flood elevation determined.
Zone AO	Flood depths of 1 to 3 feet (usually sheet flow on sloping terrain), average depths determined. For areas of alluvial fan flooding, velocities also determined.
Zone AR	Special Flood Hazard area formerly protected from the 1% annual chance flood by a flood control system that was subsequently decertified. Zone AR indicates that the formal flood control system is being restored to provide protection from the 1% annual chance or greater flood.
Zone A99	Area to be protected from 1 % annual chance flood by a federal flood protection system under construction; no base flood elevations determined.
Zone X	Areas of 0.2% annual chance flood: areas of 1% annual chance flood with average depths of less than 1 foot or with drainage areas less than 1 square mile; and areas protected by levees from 1% annual chance flood.

This determination is based on the current Flood Insurance Rate Map of the City of Patterson. This finding does not imply that the reference property will or will not be free from flooding or damage. A property not in a Special Flood Hazard Area may be damaged by a flood greater than that predicted on the FIRM or from a local drainage problem not shown on the map. This information does not create liability on the part of the city, or an officer or employee thereof, for any damage that results from reliance of this determination.
