PATTERSON HOMETOWN HEROES BANNER APPLICATION

City of Patterson Hometown Heroes Banner provides the opportunity for the community to recognize and honor Patterson residents, and their immediate family members, who have served, or currently serving, in the United States Armed Forces. The Hometown Heroes banner will be displayed from City-owned streetlight poles and will contribute to the City's quality of life while also promoting civic pride. In order to allow for a coordinated and consistent program, the City has established the following policy and guidelines for the Hometown Heroes Banner Program. Approved applications will be displayed from November 1st to October 31st.

Completed application form must have supporting documentation below:

- Proof of residency of nominee or immediate family member of the nominee (i.e., utility bill or driver license)
- Verification of service for the nominee (i.e., military orders, military ID, proof of Era of Service, ID/Badge, etc.)
- Honorable discharge or retirement papers with SSN redacted
- High-resolution digital photo of nominee in their official uniform (minimum 300 dpi in jpeg format)
 - Original photos will not be returned
 - Scanned photos are scanned as is and will not be edited by the city for clarity

Program fee of \$200 must be processed before October 1st to be accepted.
